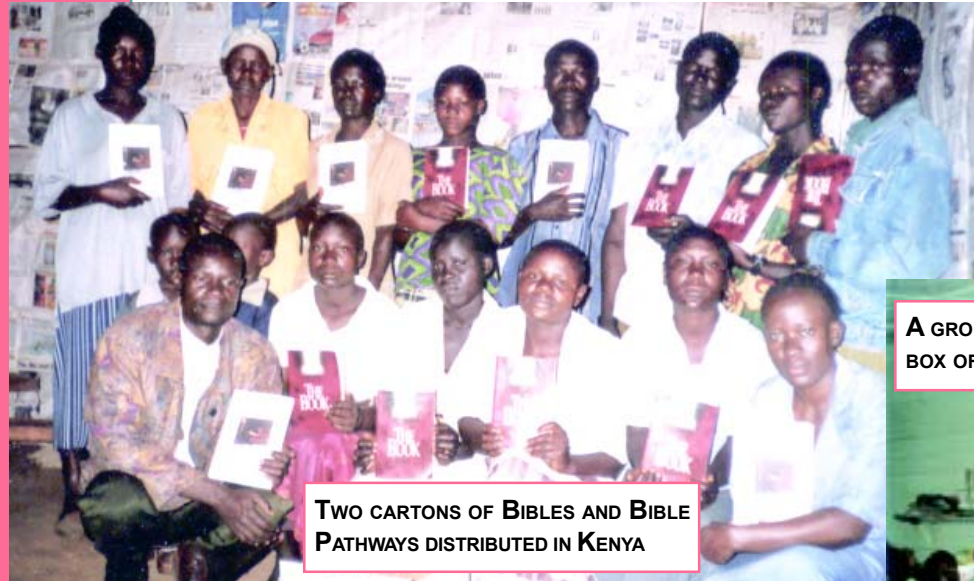


# The Word Is Spreading Like “Wild Fire” as “Modern Day Pauls” . . .
