AND THUS IT BEGAN:

One of the greatest mission visions the Lord has given me occurred early in 1989 at a meeting of the International Religious Broadcasters. I envisioned 365 people gathered together, possibly in a town square, much like Nehemiah Chapter eight. They were to read the *Bible* orally, from Genesis 1:1 to the end of Revelation without interruption over a loudspeaker, changing readers at 15-minute intervals. This would be the beginning of a possible billion people throughout the world reading the entire *Bible* during 1990. When presented with the plan, representatives from fifty countries eventually participated.

We called them *Bible Reading Marathons*. The first began with bitter cold winds sweeping across the Mount of Olives in Jerusalem as the new decade ushered in. Joyous bells from the churches in this world-famous city began to ring out. At the stroke of midnight, the late renowned Bible professor Dr. Ken Connolly began reading: **In the beginning God created . . . (Genesis 1:1)**. This initiated the year-long emphasis of reading through the *Bible* in 1990. A short time later, in America, the first *Bible Reading Marathon (BRM)* was conducted on the steps of our nation's capitol in Washington, DC, in conjunction with the National Day of Prayer ceremonies. 2007 will be our 18th consecutive marathon.

Come to Read, Come to Listen, Come to pray.
